## **Intro/Review • "True Female Beauty"**

This week Chris took a few minutes to unpack their wedding day and their racy wedding night. More importantly, as we see in this night of passion, she is his definition of beauty. In a culture that has unreal and unbiblical expectations on women, Solomon shows us that true female beauty is found in the eyes of your spouse. Chris noted that "your spouse should be your standard of beauty and the only source of romance in your life." This week, unpack the importance of this in preparation for marriage and protection of marriage.

## **Discussion Questions:**

[1] What questions do you have from Sunday's sermon? What stood out to you? What confused you?

[2] Take a minute to describe your wedding day. How was it one of the most important days of your life?

[3] What's the difference between preparing for a wedding and preparing for a marriage?

[4] **Read Song of Songs 3:6-5:1.** What stands out about how he describes his new bride? What does it mean to make your spouse your standard of beauty? How can this perspective change a marriage?

[5] What aspect of your spouse do you love the most? If you are not yet married, what is the #1 thing you look for in a prospective spouse?

[6] **Re-read 4:10.** What does it mean for your spouse to be your sister/brother & bride/groom? Why is it important to view single men and women as brothers and sisters before we develop a romantic relationship with them? (Read 1 Timothy 5:1-2)

[7] How has the series on the Song of Songs changed the way you view your marriage/relationships? How are you applying these sermons and discussions in your daily life?
